Junior Trophy for those under 18 on 1 Jan 2024. Given to the best performance rating (in any section). To be held for 12 months or until the next championship is held, whichever is sooner.

Arbiter's decision: The Arbiter's decision will be final on all matters regarding the tournament

Defaults: Players not arriving within 20 minutes of the clocks being started for each round will be defaulted. Their opponent will be repaired if possible

Prizes: In the event of a tie, prizes will be shared. No player may win more than one prize

Refreshments: Tea, coffee and biscuits will be available free of charge throughout the tournament
